

- Korea has relatively short but dynamic history of R&D in modern science and technology
 - "Imitator"
 - 1960s ~ 1970s
 - "Creative imitator (fast follower)"
 - 1980s ~ 1990s
 - "Innovator (first mover)"
 - 2000s ~



Introduction



- Even in late 1950s, first modern research infrastructure was constructed. It's societal impact was enormous.
 - Student training
 - R&D investment
 - New companies, new jobs
 - Change in energy market share
 - Network and knowledge spill-over
 - From importer to exporter

Progress in assessing societal impact of RIs in Korea



- Government-driven RI investment at the imitator phase
 - Top-down, uni-directional, state-controlled project gave large impact to the wide areas of Korean society.
 - Efficient way in the "imitator" stage for maximizing impact
- Systematic process required at the innovator stage

Progress in assessing societal impact of RIs in Korea



- Government-driven RI investment at the imitator phase
- Systematic process required at the innovator stage
 - Entering into innovator stage, demands of new RIs increased and a systematic decision-making process required.
 - Feasibility study becomes a mandatory process for any RI proposal. The CBA is an important tool.
 - Various aspects of societal value of RI evaluated and assessed.

 - Collaborative works with different institutes, organizations and with other scientific workers
 - Play a role as a pool of human and knowledge resources
